## Annual Show Exhibitor Guide

August 5 - 7, 2022

1. Show hours for the public are 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. All exhibits are expected to be staffed and operable for all three days, for all Show hours.
2. All exhibitors must pay the regular gate admission fee and must display a wristband indicating as such.
3. If your group or organization has pre-arranged or provided admission for you, you must coordinate with them to obtain a wristband prior to arriving at the gate. If you are the coordinator for a group or association, please arrange for admissions with the Show Chairperson as early as possible. Last minute group admissions may not be accommodated.
4. Anyone operating any equipment (trucks, tractors, agricultural equipment of any kind) during the Show must attend a safety meeting prior to operating said equipment, and must be wearing a safety button obtained at a meeting. There are safety meetings held at the following times:
  - a. Thursday 8:00 pm
  - b. Friday, Saturday, and Sunday 8:00 am
5. There are no additional fees to have an entry in the parade, tractor pulls, or any other event. Your gate admission is the only fee required. Parade entry registration is during the following times:
  - a. Friday 8:00 am to noon
6. Only vintage vehicles allowed on the grounds during Show hours. If you must operate a personal vehicle during the Show hours, you must be escorted by security personnel.
7. Entry to the grounds for exhibitors is via the gates specified on the Exhibitors' Map. Exhibitor equipment can be brought onto the grounds during the following days and times, within the week prior to the Show:
  - a. Monday to Wednesday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm
  - b. Thursday 9:00 am to 9:00 pm
8. Pioneer Market (Trade Fair) vendors will be allowed access to the buildings starting Thursday at 5:00 pm.
9. On-site security is limited. You should leave nothing of a sensitive nature unattended at any time. *All exhibitor-owned equipment or wares are on Pioneer Acres grounds at their owners' own risk. Pioneer Acres assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to third party goods.*
10. All exhibitor equipment and wares must be removed by Monday 5:00 pm. Exhibitor equipment (including trade fair wares) can be removed during the following times after the Show:
  - a. Sunday 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm
  - b. Monday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm
11. Shuttles run between the exhibitor parking and the Show grounds on a regular basis. Shuttle hours are:
  - a. Friday 8:00 am to 6:00 pm
  - b. Saturday 8:00 am to 6:00 pm
  - c. Sunday 8:00 am to 6:00 pm
