**All buildings open:** Visit our displays in the Grain Academy, the Granlea Beef Ring, Pioneer World, the Long Historic House, Crown School, Car and Truck Buildings, Stationary Engine Building, Blacksmith Shop, Wheelwright, Steam Building, Ray Howden Collection Building, and Ron Carey Collection Building. Visit the Bunk Car and Cook Car used by the pioneers to support the threshing crews during harvest in those early years.

**Concessions** located by the Pioneer World Building (outside) and Pioneer Acres Concession on the north end of Pioneer World building (inside). Lions Club **steak supper** starts at 5:30 pm on Friday and Saturday.

ATM on Site Located in the main entrance to Pioneer World.

Washrooms are located throughout the grounds and indicated by a w on the map (see over). Wheelchair-accessible washrooms are indicated by a on the map (see over).

**People Movers** travel around the grounds and parking lots all day. Just wait at a designated stop, as indicated by a on the map (see over).

**Red Horse Barn** Harnessing and hitching for various events and horsepower exhibits all day. Take a **FREE** horse-drawn wagon ride around the grounds.

**Farrier demonstration**—watch a live horse shoeing afternoons from 1:30 - 2:30 pm near the Red Barn.

**Blacksmith Shop** Check out live demonstrations in the Blacksmith Shop all three days of the show.

*Mini Threshing* Watch a live demo on a scaled down model of a threshing machine set-up built by long-time member Ken Grove in the mid-1980's. Now operated and maintained by Wayne Grove and Family. You may have seen them in the Calgary Stampede!

*Grain Academy* Our newest exhibit came to us from its original home at the Calgary Stampede grounds in 2020. Exhibits document the production and transportation of grain from the early pioneering days to modern times. 
