

All Buildings Open! Visit our displays in the Grain Academy, the Granlea Beef Ring, Pioneer World, the Long Historic House, Crown School, Car and Truck Buildings, Stationary Engine Building, Blacksmith Shop, Wheelwright, Steam Building, Ray Howden Collection Building, and Ron Carey Collection Building. Visit the Bunk Car and Cook Car used by the pioneers to support the threshing crews during harvest in those early years.

CONCESSIONS Concession choices include Pioneer Acres Concession – front side of Pioneer World; Food trucks near the Ray Howden building; Ice cream truck at north end of Poleshed; Supper starts at 5:00 pm daily at Concession by the Premier Auctions tent.

ATM ON SITE Located in the Pioneer World Building.

WASHROOMS are located throughout the grounds and indicated by a **W** on the map (see over). Wheelchair-accessible washrooms are indicated by a  on the map (see over).

PEOPLE MOVERS travel around the grounds and parking lots all day. Just wait at a designated stop, as indicated by a **P** on the map.

RED HORSE BARN Harnessing and hitching for various events and horsepower exhibits all day. Live horse shoeing afternoons near the Red Barn. Take a Free horse-drawn wagon ride around the grounds.

BLACKSMITH AND WHEELWRIGHTS SHOPS Open daily, view exhibits, live wheelwright demonstrations every day at 2:30 pm.

MINI THRESHING Watch a live demo on a scale model of a threshing outfit built by long-time member Ken Grove in the 1980's. Now operated and maintained by his son Wayne Grove and family, you may have seen them at the Calgary Stampede!

GRAIN ACADEMY Our newest exhibit came to us from its original home at the Calgary Stampede grounds in 2020. Exhibits document the production and transportation of grain from the early pioneering days to modern times. See the NEW historic collection of 16 botanical watercolour plant images in the antique boxcar.

PIONEER WORLD BUILDING Western Heritage memorabilia, dioramas, exhibits, gifts & souvenirs, quilt & craft display, and homemade baking for sale. See the beautiful display of Singer Sewing Machines in the Gallery.

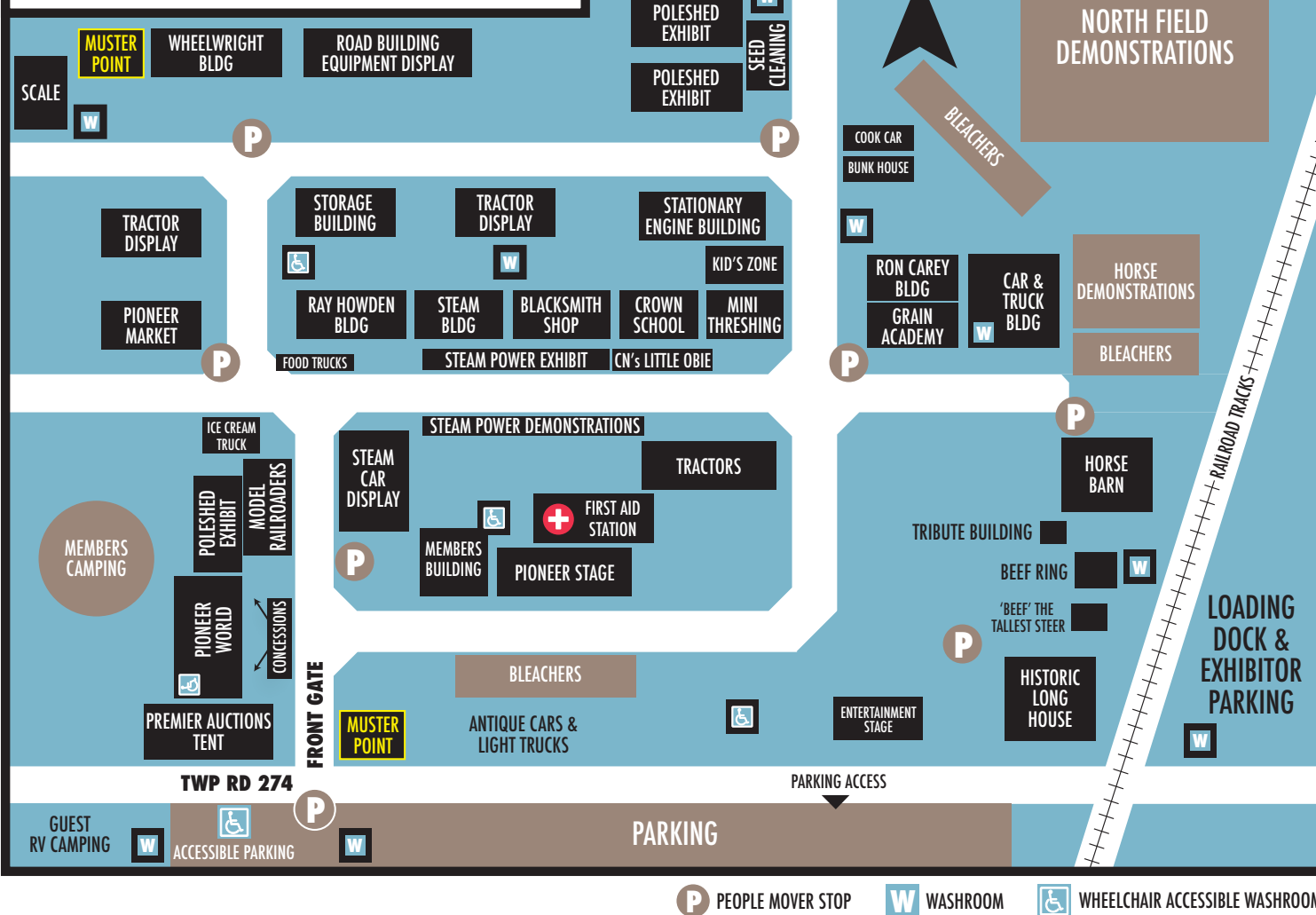
