When? <u>June 3,4 and 5</u> from 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on each day.

Where? At Pioneer Acres of Alberta Museum: 1 km North of Irricana; 45 minutes North-East of Calgary.

Why? To give students a hands-on opportunity to experience pioneer life on the prairies.

Who? Kids Days is an opportunity for teachers of students grades 2-8 to show their students first-hand what some of their curriculum topics are all about. Your students will engage with passionate volunteers who will teach your students all about pioneer life and work on the prairies.

What? Visiting students will be able to see and be a part of a working blacksmith shop, sewing, quilting, washing clothes, threshing crew bunk houses, a one room school house, antique tractors and farm equipment, horses and horse drawn wagons, cars and trucks, crafts, hand water pumps, rope-making, a wagon ride, farm animals and more.
