**All buildings open:** Visit our displays in the Grain Academy, the Granlea Beef Ring, Pioneer World, the Long Historic House, Crown School, Car and Truck Buildings, Stationary Engine Building, Blacksmith Shop, Wheelwright and Steam Building, and Ray Howden Collection Building. Visit the Bunk Car and Cook Car used by the pioneers to support the threshing crews during harvest in those early years.

**Concessions** located throughout the grounds. Lions Club steak supper 5:30 – 6:30 pm Friday and Saturday.

**ATM on Site** Located in the Pioneer World Building next to the main concession booth by the Front Gate.

**Washrooms** are located throughout the grounds. Wheelchair accessible washrooms are located at the south end of Pioneer World. Washroom locations are indicated by a **W** on the map (see over).

**People Movers** travel around the grounds and parking lots all day. Just wait at a designated stop, as indicated by a **P** on the map (see over).

**Farrier demonstration** Watch a live horse shoeing afternoons from 2:00 – 4:00 pm near the Red Barn.
